Language Arts:

We will focus on “The ABC's of Learning” We will spend one week with each short vowel. We will read non fiction and fiction stories. We will ask and answer questions using key details in the text. We will focus on sequencing stories using Beginning, Middle, and end. We will identify characters and settings.

Math: We will focus on number sense. Count within 100 and relate counting to addition and subtraction. We will learn about the properties of addition and subtraction using unknown parts. $6+?=10$

Writing: We will go over handwriting skills and correct ways to write sentences using capitals and punctuation. We will begin writing narrative stories with time order words.

Social Studies: We will learn how to be good citizens in all settings. Why rules are important and how to keep each other safe.

Science We will go over science safety for future experiments.

Homework: Please read every evening and record a few sentences about your book. Practice math addition and subtraction through 10.
