Learning Focus



Language Arts - We will retell familiar stories, including key details. We will ask and answer questions about unknown words in a text. We will name the author and illustrator and the roles of each. We will identify the main topic and key details of informational texts.

Math - We will count to 100 by ones and tens, count on beginning from any given number, write numbers 0-20, represent a number with a numeral, and add and subtract within 10. We will compose and decompose numbers 11-19 into ten ones and leftover ones.

Writing - We will use drawing, dictating, and writing to compose narrative and opinion pieces.

Social Studies - We will learn how people adapt to seasonal weather conditions in their environment.

Science - We will understand change and observable patterns of weather that occur from season to season.
